The UNDERSIGNED hereby represent and warrant that they are the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of the Minor CONTESTANT named above and that they have the full power, authority, capacity and right, without limitation, to execute, deliver and perform this Release.

Request to Participant. The UNDERSIGNED hereby request that the MINOR CONTESTANT be granted permission to enter the restricted areas and participate as a contestant in the Little Rodeo competition (hereinafter referred to as "Event").

Consideration. In consideration of MINOR CONTESTANT being allowed to participate in the event, the UNDERSIGNED hereby agree to the terms of this Contestant Waiver and Release Form.

Acknowledgment of Risk. The UNDERSIGNED understand and acknowledge that rodeos and related livestock events are dangerous activities and that participation in a rodeo or related livestock event exposes the participant to a substantial and serious hazard which may result in property damage and/or personal injury or death. The UNDERSIGNED expressly acknowledge that the participation of the above-named MINOR CONTESTANT will expose the MINOR CONTESTANT to such hazards.

Release of Sponsor. The UNDERSIGNED, being fully aware that participation by the above named MINOR CONTESTANT in the Event will expose the MINOR CONTESTANT to a substantial and serious risk of property damage and/or personal injury or death, hereby releases sponsors and the Matagorda County Fair & Livestock Association (hereinafter "RELEASEES"), from liability, and waives the right to sue, for any and all property damage and/or personal injuries or death, or other claims arising from the above named MINOR CONTESTANT'S participation in the Event, even if the property damage and/or personal injury or death is determined to have resulted from the negligent acts or omissions of the RELEASEES.

Covenant Not to Sue. The UNDERSIGNED covenant that they shall not now or at any time in the future, directly or indirectly, commence or prosecute any action, suit, or other proceeding against the RELEASEES, their officers, directors, employees, agents, assigns or affiliates for damages of any type arising from participation of the above-named MINOR CONTESTANT in the Event, whether such claims be for the benefit of the UNDERSIGNED or of the MINOR CONTESTANT.

Indemnification. To the fullest extent permitted by law, the UNDERSIGNED hereby agree to defend and indemnify and to hold RELEASEE(S) harmless from any liability, claims, demands, causes of action, loss and/or damage arising from participation of the above-named MINOR CONTESTANT in the Event, even if caused by the negligent acts or omissions of any of the RELEASEE(S).

Matagorda County Fair Association reserves the right to use all photographs taken during this event for our publicity.

Rules & Information Sheet

1. Entries will be accepted beginning at 8:30 a.m. Wednesday, February 12, 2025, at the Fair Office. We will accept the first 20 completed applicants in each age group. 2-3 Year Old, 4-5 Year Old, 6-7 Year Old
2. This event will be held on Friday, March 7, 2025, in the main arena immediately following the Rodeo Clown Contest.
3. Entries will not be accepted without (1) CONTESTANT WAIVER AND RELEASE FORM, (2) ENTRY FEE of \$40.00 and (3) a copy of BIRTH CERTIFICATE.
4. You, **the parent of the Little Rodeo Contestant**, must sign your child in at the **General Admission Area in the Alley way at the back of the arena**. A Contestant Number will be issued at that time and must be worn during the event. **YOU MUST BE THE PARENT/GAURDIAN OF THE PARTICIPANT to sign him/her in and out after the event**. Your child will not be accepted as a participant or released to a brother/sister, aunt/uncle, or grandparent.
6. Proper rodeo attire must be worn. Long sleeve shirts and pants are required.
7. **Only one parent is allowed in the arena** during Little Rodeo.
8. **No** open toed shoes, Sleeveless or short sleeved shirts, ropes or spurs are accepted.
9. **NO RE-RUNS.**

AWARDS

The Little Rodeo Contestant that receives the highest score in each event in each age group will win a trophy. The Little Rodeo Contestant that receives the highest score overall in each age group will be deemed champion and receive a buckle. All other participants will receive a participation award.
